Change proposals to the structure of main grid fees, part 2 - Grid service fees that better reflect costs

- 1) Do you consider the proposed new tariff bases to be appropriate as a whole? If not, why?
- 2) General feedback on the change proposals:
 - a. Transition of main grid service billing from hourly to 15-minute intervals
 - b. More power-based tariffing and weighting of the billing interface at the main grid connection point
 - c. Regional loss fees replacing main grid input and output fees
 - d. Voltage-spesific pricing
 - e. Introduction of a new system service fee
- 3) What should be considered in the more detailed design of changes to the tariff components?
 - a. Appendix 1 (only in Finnish) presents different models for power-based fee for consumption. Which do you recommend and why?
 - b. If a power-based fee for consumption is to be introduced, should the current time-differentiated energy-based consumption fee be retained alongside it, or should the power-based fee be time-differentiated to incentivize electricity consumption shifting, for example, to night-time hours?
 - c. Other feedback.
- 4) What would be a realistic schedule for the changes? What should be considered in their implementation? What kind of transition periods are needed?
- 5) Would you like to be contacted to arrange a bilateral discussion on the matter in early 2026 (January–March)?
